Our Bowflag® passed all the quality checks performed after the test without showing any damages. This positively certifies that they are among the strongest Bowflags available.

Wind speed test Bowflag® Basic

Single sided Bowflag® Basic withstands wind speeds of 50 km/h (wind force 6) without showing any damage.



Our **double sided Bowflag® Basic** manages a moderate breeze (wind force 4, 28 km/h) which is understood to be a fair standard under test conditions



Wind speed test Bowflag® Select

Our **single sided Bowflag® Select** has proved to be stable in excess of wind force 10, however we recommend that the Bowflag® Select is flown in winds measuring force 8 (74 km/h) to avoid any damage.



The **double sided Bowflag® Select** is also strong enough to be flown in winds up to force 8.
